## Images in clinical Medicine -Anatomical Variation - Rib bridging

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This is an anatomical variation most common between the 1st and 2nd

ribs, and is typically unilateral. It may be present in one or more pair of ribs. It is known as Srb's anomaly. The bridges may be complete, or pseudarthrosis may be present. In a Korean study 5.000 chest x-rays of healthy adults were studied. Rib bridging was the fourth most common anatomical variation and most involved first and second ribs (42.9%).








FIGURE 2. A, B, C.
